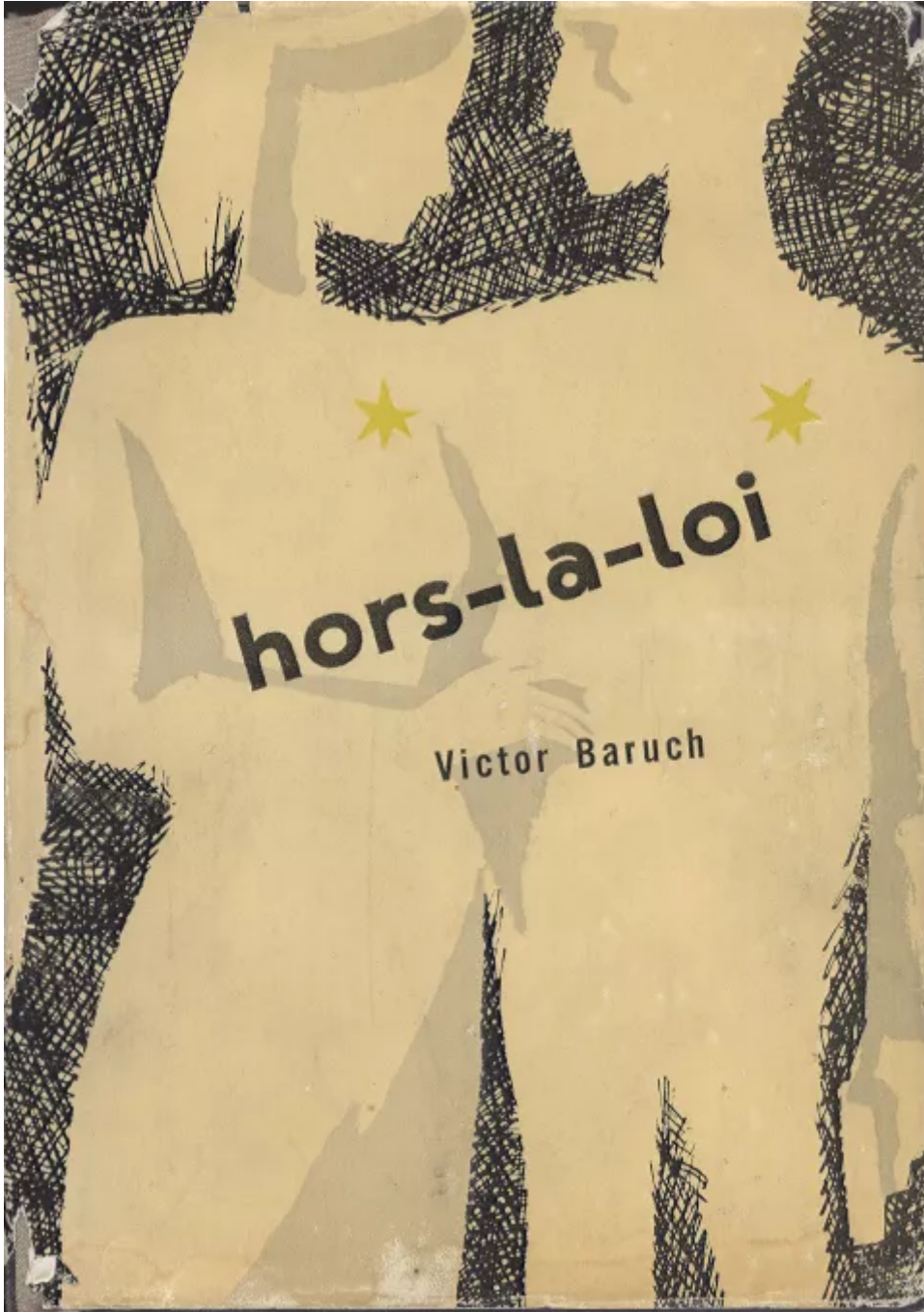


The French Edition Of Victor Baruh's Book 'Beyond The Law'

For example, there is a description of the demonstration on 24th May 1943 against the internment of Jews from Sofia. I remember that a young man took a flag off a green wooden fence and walked with it at the head of the procession. This scene is in the book. When the writer Dragomir Assenov [pen name of Jacques Nisim Melamed - a well-known Bulgarian writer (1926-1981)] read this in my book, he said: 'That was me'.
