We got married in 1950. Jasia, or Janka, or Janina, maiden name Aneksztejn, was born in Warsaw in 1923. She went to a Polish gymnasium on Miodowa Street, but had Jewish friends. She had aunts, one in Holland, and another one, who survived the war in Russia, then went to London with her husband, we used to go there.
