Faculty at Moscow University before the revolution of 1917. After the revolution he lectured at the same university. In 1937 uncle Grigoriy was arrested. He was accused of an attempted encroachment on Stalin. He went on hunger strike in jail of which he died. We found out the details of Grigoriy's death only after Stalin died.
