Thanks to Rosa that worked at the Russian Drama theater our family could go to the evacuation in Alma-Ata (the capital of Kazakh SSR) pretending that we were employees at the theater. We left in July 1941. In Alma-Ata we felt that we were Jews. We couldn't find a job. My wife found one as an accountant at a small office. Manya's daughter Ella took my son to the kindergarten.
