

Family History Video

<u>Goal:</u> You will create a video that tells the story of how one of your relatives immigrated to another country in order to share a theme about immigration.

Final Project: The video will be a series of pictures that you will narrate modeled after the video's we've studied on Centropa.

Here are the skills we'll work on:

- 1. Tell a story with a theme
- 2. Provide "evidence" for that theme with the details of your story
- 3. Research a topic and create a cohesive video with all the different research components

Factual Elements you'll need to research:

- 1. Tell the historical background of the time period
- 2. Tell the historical background of the country
- 3. Tell the story of the person who came to his/her new country including:
 - Why he/she left
 - The ease or difficulty of the trip
 - The conditions when he/she got to the new country

Required Research:

- 1. Websites
- 2. Books (we'll take a trip or two to the library!)
- 3. Oral or written histories from your family

Pictures

You need to find pictures to help you tell your story. These pictures can include:

- 1. Old family photos
- 2. Pictures of the country of origin
- 3. Pictures of the new country
- 4. Pictures of your current family
- 5. Anything else that you reference in your video

Theme

Your story cannot just be chronological facts. Through your story, you must share an idea about the human experience.

Remember a theme is a lesson or moral about people or life. This is what you want to focus on as you write your storyboard.
