

She had 10 siblings, most of whom also moved to Putnok where the interviewee's mother moved. The interviewee remembers only 6 siblings with whom they had regular contact.

1. and 2. Twins: Bela and Sandor born in 1892. Bela was a shoemaker, lived in Putnok. His wife Helen died in child birth. Sandor lived in Karcag and had 4 children. They emigrated to Israel in 1947.

3. Szeren – her husband Bela Muller was a baker (he died in 1928 in Miskolc) and they had 4 children. The eldest was a barber in his mother's shop, their daughter learnt how to make the upper part of shoes, another son Pista became a merchant and he is still alive and the third son Ferenc became a shoemaker.

4. Jolan – got married and had a daughter but then she divorced and never found another husband. She became a servant in the house of a middle school director

5. Jozsef – lived in Mezokeresztes, traded in animals

6. Margit – lived in Szanto
