

My parents went to the synagogue on holidays and on Sabbath, they observed some Jewish traditions: they had a traditional dinner on Sabbath, but nobody said a prayer, there were just dinner parties on holidays; they wore ordinary clothes. My parents only covered their heads, when going to the synagogue, Mama did not eat pork, while my father was very fond of pork.
