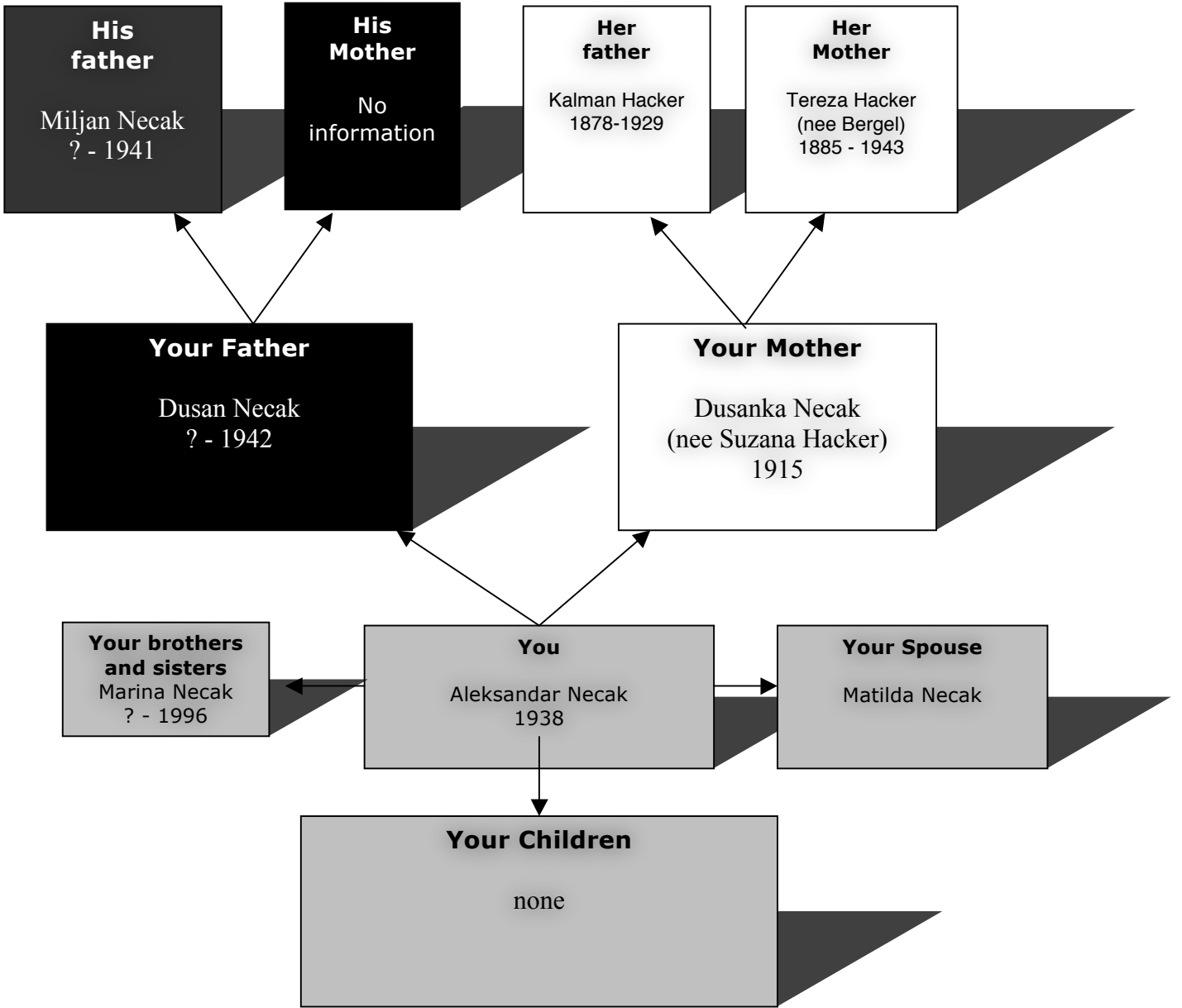


She was not too observant.

Andras Bergel, studied pharmacology in Budapest, magyarized his name to Ormos, married a Hungarian Jewish woman named Suzana Halpert. They lived in Senta until deportation, they poisoned themselves on their way to Auschwitz.

Where was she during the Holocaust?

Killed in concentration camp in Auschwitz.
