

My parents were religious; my mother was more religious than my father. She stopped being religious because of the sudden death of my father. Mother fasted on Yom Kippur only as long as her parents were alive, after that she stopped. All the religious education I have came mostly from my grandparents. Grandfather used to pray with tefillin every morning, and Grandmother lit the candles every Friday evening and said the blessing.
