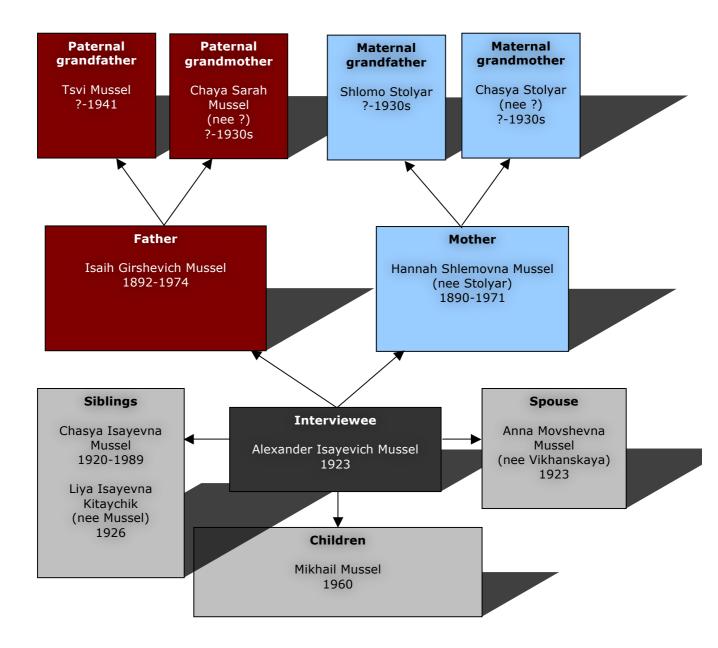

Riva Etl (Revekka): 1889-1981, Zarasay, Cape Town (South Africa), emigrated in 1933 with her husband Kusiel Abramovich Levin;

Chava Rasel: died at the age of 23

Feiga (Feicha Hamburg): husband – Chaim Hamburg
