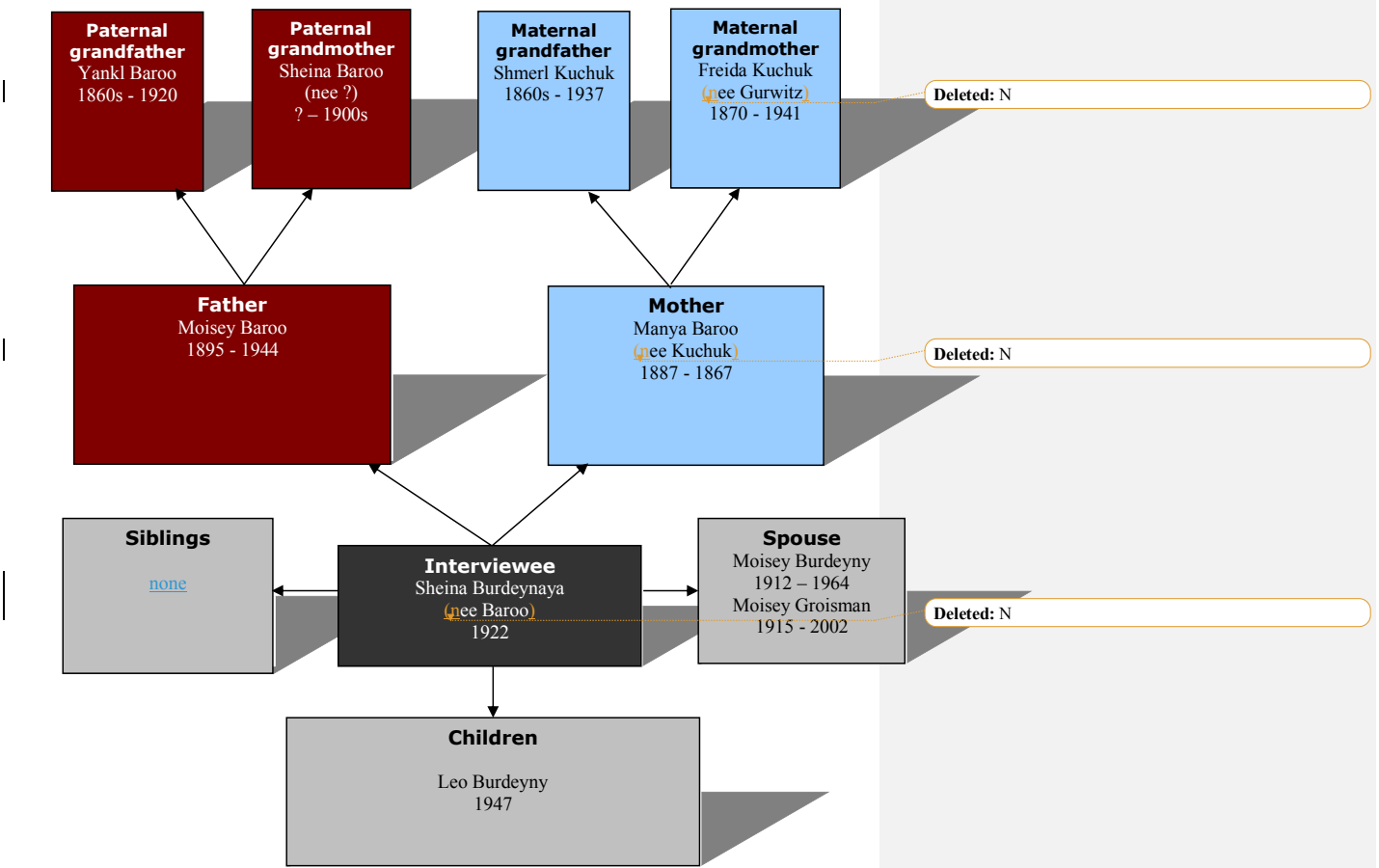

Gitl ? (nee Baroo) (1890s - 1942): housewife, Rybnitsa town, married, four children. She and her children Mina, Solomon, Yasha and Dora were killed in the ghetto in Rybnitsa.

Myndl Eikilis (1900s - 1941): housewife, Odessa, married. Her husband and she were killed in Odessa ghetto.

Abram Baroo (1912 - 1980): Rybnitsa town, barber.

Srul Kuchuk (1890s – 1940s): assistant accountant, Odessa, married, two daughters, died in evacuation. One of the daughter lives in Germany other in Russia.

Tsyzia Krutianskaya (nee Kuchuk) (1890s – 1940s): housewife, Rashkov (Moldavia), married, husband owned a wine store, two children: son Boria and daughter Fira. She and her children were killed by Romanians. Her husband perished at the front.

Soibl Indman (nee Kuchuk) (1890 – 1942): housewife, Odessa, married, had a son. She and her son were killed in the ghetto in Odessa. Her husband perished at the front.

Vitia Tsybulskaya (nee Kuchuk) (1900s – 1943): housewife, Gershunovka village near Rybnitsa, married, two children. Germans killed her children in 1941. Vitia perished in the ghetto in Rybnitsa.
